

Digi-Vu Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy is designed to help you understand our data processing practices of your information through the use of the Internet and the World Wide Web by Digi-Vu Ltd and associated third parties.

We are based at Digi-Vu Ltd, 66 High Street, Barwell, Leicestershire, LE9 8DR. We are a limited company and registered with Companies House, our Company Registration Number is 6340388. We are registered with the Information Commissioners Office, under the Data Protection Act 1998, number PZ9826605. The information we collect about you and your use of the Digi-Vu.co.uk Site will be held by Digi-Vu Ltd at the above address. You can use our Site without providing us your details, however, to get the most out of the site, products and services we may ask for personal information about you which we will endeavour to keep secure.

As we develop our Site we may change the way we process your personal information. Please ensure you check this Privacy Policy on a regular basis so that you are aware of any changes. By using our Site you agree with our Privacy Policy. Should you wish your personal details to be handled in a different way you need to write to us informing us of the way you wish your information to be handled.

In general, we use the information we collect about you to:

- Give you information about products and services to and from relevant third parties which have been carefully selected by us.
- Develop and improve the features, products and services we can offer you
- Support and develop our own marketing campaigns and promotional efforts.

Personal information collection & usage

When you visit, register or use the services on this Site, you may be asked to provide certain information about yourself, including your name and your contact details. Finally, we may collect information about your property and the type of property you wish to purchase.

Email communication

Should you wish to send a friend an email through this Site we will not use this person's email address for marketing purposes. It will be used internally so that we can analyse the usage of the Site.

If you register your personal details with us and select the email update feature you will receive information from us that matches the property criteria you have chosen in our Site. We will then email you when properties are added to the Site that are the same as your property criteria.

Registering your personal details with us

If you chose to register your personal details with us, we save those details and use them to create a more personalised service to you. You can update your details whenever suits you. When you log in to the Site, our database will automatically load your personal details and your saved property searches.

Property Searches

You can use this Site and complete property searches without registering your details with us. If you wish to save the searches you have conducted then you will need to register your personal details with us. If you register your details with us you can save any properties that you are interested in. We do not give this information to any third parties.

Who has access to the information you provide or we collect

We retain access to all the personal information you have given us or have collected from you. Should your personal information be passed to one of our carefully selected third party sites we are not responsible for their practices or their privacy policies, even if you click on a link from our Site to theirs. It is your responsibility to check the privacy policy of every site that you visit and ensure that you are satisfied with the terms and conditions of the sites privacy policy.

Cookies and tracking
